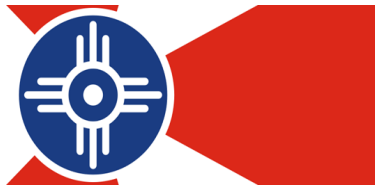

The Atwater Neighborhood Resource Center provides a wide array of services. In addition to City services, it is an excellent source of information. You can find out what is occurring in your City Council District and/or neighborhood and learn how you can get involved.



The Atwater staff is available to help you navigate City services; whether it is a housing issue, potholes in the street, or animal issues — we are here to help serve you and answer your questions.

The Neighborhood Resource Center can also help you access your City Council Member and make sure that your representative is aware of your concerns.

SERVICES AVAILABLE AT ATWATER NEIGHBORHOOD RESOURCE CENTER

- Eight public computers are available. Priority usage will be given to those conducting job searches or educational projects. Computers are available 8:30 a.m. to 5:15 p.m. Monday - Thursday. 8:30 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. on Friday.
- FREE faxing and notary service
- Limited photo copying
- Administrative Aide available to provide resources and community assistance.
- FREE meeting space for community organizations during regular business hours.
- Workforce Center information available for resume building and job searching.
- Seasonal Programs:
 1. FREE tax preparation (February- April)
 2. FREE lunch-Filling the Gap (March/August)
 3. Operation Holiday Registration (November)

SERVICES AVAILABLE AT ATWATER NEIGHBORHOOD RESOURCE CENTER

- Metropolitan Area Building and Construction Department (MABCD) - Four Neighborhood Inspectors are housed at center to cover the north and northeast section of the district.
- Community Services Representative available to respond to neighborhood concerns and help with problem solving. Also serves as a liaison to the District I City Council representative.
- Department for Children and Families (DCF) – social workers and benefits caseworker are stationed here to assist families.
- Wichita Independent Neighborhoods, Inc. (WIN) provides education, resources, and an effective voice for current and potential members of WIN on quality of life issues in Sedgwick
- Lynette Woodard Recreation Center coordinates classes and events for the community.
- AARP-Real Possibilities provides workshops for ages 40+
