**Subject: Guidelines for City of Wichita Street
Lighting Program**

Effective April 15, 1980, the following guidelines will be in effect for the City of Wichita's street lighting program:

1. Residential Street Lightning
 - a. Existing areas – incandescent lights will be replaced by mercury vapor lights in a one-for-one exchange, except a mid-block light will be removed when the existing footcandles can be maintained with a lesser number of fixtures. No additional mid-block lights will be installed.
 - b. New areas – mercury vapors will be installed at each intersection and mid-block at 500'-700' intervals.
2. Arterials

Incandescents only will be replaced on the 64 miles of arterial streets with High Pressure Sodium lights to provide .75 IES standard.
3. Freeways

0.6 maintained footcandles.
4. High Crime Areas

No more than ten per year to be installed.
5. Removal of Existing Lights

Recommendation for removal of lights will be made when lighting exceeds .75 IES standard.
