

WEB Procedures: AMBULANCE DRIVER AND EMT

The following information is a summary of the City's ordinance and is not intended to cover everything included within the ordinance. Whenever summarization creates a conflict, the official ordinance governs. A copy of the entire ordinance is available for review at the City Clerk's office, 455 N. Main – 13th floor, or directly from the Internet at www.wichita.gov.

BASIS Any person acting as a driver or Emergency Medical Technician of an ambulance.

LEGAL REFERENCE Chapter 3.80, Code of the City of Wichita, Kansas.

REGULATIONS Check with the Environmental Health Department, 1900 E 9th, 268-8351.

ENFORCING AUTHORITY Environmental Health Department

FEES

Ambulance Driver (New).....	\$15.00
Ambulance Driver (Renewal).....	5.00
EMT Basic (New & Renewal).....	5.00
EMT Advanced (New & Renewal).....	5.00

EMTs performing duties as ambulance drivers are, in addition, required to obtain a driver's license in which case the total fee is twenty dollars (\$20.00).

Fees shall not be refunded for any reason. Drivers, having qualified, may renew their license at any time from December 1 to December 20, inclusive, for the fee of \$5.00. However, if the driver fails to renew his license between those dates he shall be considered a new applicant, shall pay the fifteen dollar (\$15.00) fee, and be required to take the regular examination.

Licenses are due annually expiring December 31.

PROCEDURE Applicant applies at Environmental Health (1900 E 9th).
