

ICE CREAM VENDOR

BASIS Any person, firm, partnership, or corporation who travels by any type of vehicle from house to house or place to place, selling or offering for sale any ice cream foodstuffs within the city limits of Wichita. No person, firm, partnership, or corporation shall be considered an ice cream street vendor when orders are taken for ice cream foodstuffs to be delivered on a day other than the date of sale.

LEGAL REFERENCE Chapter 3.89, Code of the City of Wichita, Kansas.

REGULATIONS The Environmental Health Department and the Police Department must approve the applicant and the vehicle yearly. If a motorized vehicle, the licensee must have a valid Kansas driver's license.

A certificate of insurance must be filed with the City covering all motorized vehicles. The liability insurance must have coverage of not less than \$100,000 for injury to all persons injured in any one occurrence, and not less than \$75,000 for property damage per each occurrence.

No fee shall be charged for a license to an honorably discharged veteran who has been a resident of Sedgwick County for at least 6 months immediately preceding license application. No fee shall be charged for a license to any charitable organization that has existed in the City for at least 6 months immediately preceding license application.

Allow 30 days for approval
