II. Approval of Minutes

Bohm asked the board to review the minutes from last month. Hillman & Mitchell made a motion to approve the minutes and the group seconded. Bohm introduced a guest for the record, Thomas Spillman, Boy Scout in Wichita. Mr. Spillman a student of Northeast High School is working towards his Eagle Scout rank in his badge for Citizenship in the Community.

III. Other Business

Gary Oborny was not in attendance at the start of the meeting to start the discussion about the BMPs so Bohm asked Lindebak about the progress of the offsite BMP program. Lindebak responded that he and Tom Stiles with KDHE had discussed briefly this past week and they plan to get together again next week and start to frame up the concept policy and bring back to SWAB next month.

Bohm also wanted to inform the board that the City of Newton, Susan Loomis, has asked if Scott Lindebak and Chris Bohm would mind meeting with the Clean 20 Coalition in Newton on June 20th, to talk about what SWAB has been doing over the last year and a half.

Bohm again asked if there was any other business to discuss and Hillman responded that he would like to know from Lindebak what he envisioned the stormwater banking process. What are the concepts? Lindebak responded that they are looking at a numeric number, how many pounds of pollutants does a one acre development generate. They have looked at different pounds and based on that they need to work with Ron Graber and Dr. Barnes to see what applicable BMPs are in a rural setting that could be implemented to achieve the reduction. The implementation would probably be up to the board he thinks the WRAPS would be the one to implement but the funding is still yet to be determined.

Bohm states that Allison & Oborny have joined the meeting so the review of the BMP practices can proceed.

IV. Review Past 24 months of Wichita Stormwater Water Quality BMP Practices

Bohm asked Lindebak to go over the data that he had compiled and sent to the board. Public & private records that the City has have been converted to Lucity. There were 46 records that were input not everything on the list is BMP. In the comments field of each report it was noted what type of BMP was used and the developer or owner name is available but because the projects were private there was not a unit cost provided. Discussion went on between board members on the different BMPs currently being used and the costs associated with them. Oborny suggested that he, Bohm, and Allison get together and create a survey on cost for water quality and downstream channel protection if applicable. Bohm stated that next month's meeting will be dedicated to a draft policy/framework for a program. Hillman stated that he would like to see a draft survey if it is available.

Action: Scott Lindebak & Tom Stiles w/ KDHE will provide a draft/framework policy for review, Task Committee – Bohm, Oborny, Allison to provide survey if draft form available by next meeting.
