

Conduct

If an organization has four or more major occurrences or eight or more normal occurrences that organization will be removed from the league.

Major occurrences include but are not limited to:

- Fighting (parents and coaches)
- Alcohol or Drugs at any GWJFL game or practice.
- Assault
- Cheating (includes playing an illegal/ineligible player)

Normal occurrences include but are not limited to:

- Any ejection (player, coach or spectator)
- Player altercations
- Misconduct at any GWJFL gathering or meeting
- Failure to comply with practice dates
- Failure to comply with registration deadlines
- Failure to comply with instructions given by any GWJFL administration (includes field supervisors)

Miscellaneous:

Ejected coaches and spectators will serve a one game suspension on first offense; second offense will be an automatic three game suspension.

A player that throws a punch will serve a minimum one game suspension.

Coaches or spectators caught in possession of drugs or alcohol at any GWJFL game or practice will serve an automatic three game suspension for the first offense. Second offense will result in a two year ban from all league activity.

It is the responsibility of the organizations director and coaches to make sure parents that are suspended do not attend games. Failure to do so will result in a suspension for the head coach.

Coaches caught playing illegal players will receive a two year ban from all GWJFL activity.

A team caught practicing with equipment before the allowed date will not be allowed to participate in the "City Bowl", week eight.

***The league office maintains the authority to differentiate from penalties mentioned above as deemed necessary on a case by case basis.**
