

AUCTION SALE

BASIS Any person who conducts any auction or auction sale wherein personal property is sold or offered for sale at public auction in the city, except as provided for auction sales of precious stones, jewelry, etc., and auctions at regularly licensed auction houses.

LEGAL REFERENCE Chapter 3.36, Code of the City of Wichita, Kansas.

REGULATIONS At least five days prior to the date of sale, the applicant shall file an inventory of goods to be auctioned with the License Activity. Such inventory shall state the place where the auction sale is to be conducted and shall contain a complete and accurate description of goods to be auctioned. Auction sale licenses, fees, and regulations shall not apply to: persons vacating urban renewal areas; property taken and sold under the provisions of chattel mortgages; conditional sales contracts by warehousemen for storage liens; property sold by sheriffs, constables, and other officials acting under an order of court; sales of precious stones, jewelry, etc.; real property.

If any merchandise for the sale is brought in from out of state, contact the County Assessor before the sale and notify him of the sale, location, date, and time.

Sale bill must state date, time, location, auction company and address, auctioneer for the sale, and the merchandise inventory.

There is not a license for a raffle. The raffle must be conducted in such a manner that it does not violate the city ordinances and state statutes regarding gambling. To be within the law, they can only request a donation of a certain amount in return for a raffle ticket. If a person does not wish to give the donation amount, or wants to give anything less, they must still allow the person to have a ticket. Raffle tickets cannot be sold, they are given away with the recipient giving a suggested donation in return.
