

AUTO WRECKING

BASIS Any person engaged in the business of buying, acquiring, or dealing in motor vehicles to be wrecked, dismantled, or disassembled, or anyone who maintains or uses any building, premise or place to wreck, dismantle, or disassemble any motor vehicle and who sells the parts thereof.

LEGAL

REFERENCE Chapter 3.48, Code of the City of Wichita, Kansas.
Fencing requirements: Section 28.04.184, Code of the City of Wichita, Kansas

REGULATIONS Each licensee shall be required to procure one license for each place of business. Licenses are non-transferable.

The activities of a motor vehicle wrecker shall be conducted entirely within a closed building; unless the property used exceeds an area of 15,000 square feet. If so, the City Council may grant permission to enclose the property with a fence or wall, and no motor vehicle or part thereof shall be parked, stored, or displayed on the outside of such building, fence, or wall.

Fencing shall conform in all respects to the zoning ordinance when applicable. Solid fencing requirements may be waived by the City Council for non-conforming uses if the property is not adjacent to residential zoned districts, and the property is enclosed by a six foot high chain link or woven wire fence with a three-strand barbed wire extension at the top completely enclosing the business operation.

Every motor vehicle wrecker shall maintain a book of records in which at the time of acquiring or purchasing a motor vehicle, he shall record a full and accurate record of such transaction, which record shall at all times be accessible to the Police Department.

Any licensee who has a current auto wrecking license in his possession does not need a secondhand dealer's license or a scrap processor's license.
