

MISCELLANEOUS SALE, GARAGE SALE, ETC.

A miscellaneous sale is any garage, basement, yard, rummage, or other similar sale of six (6) or more items that were originally purchased by the applicant for his/her use or consumption. No person(s) of the immediate family residing with the applicant shall have more than two (2) sales in a calendar year - and at least six (6) months apart - and for no longer than three (3) consecutive days for each sale on residential property. Once a permit is issued, the date/time of the sale may only be modified prior to the date/time the sale is scheduled to begin. Schools, churches and non-profit organizations may have sales for the benefit of the organization only, with no restrictions on the number of days, when the sale is held on the school, church, or commercial property and providing that the organization pays the fee as required.

Licenses may be purchased online (<https://license.wichita.gov/GarageSale/login.aspx>) or in person at *The Wichita Eagle* and at City of Wichita Licensing, 1st Floor, 455 N. Main. The permit fee is \$2.50 per day. Online permits require a credit card transaction for which there is a \$1 convenience fee.

All permitted garage sales are listed on the City's online garage sale web site. Permit holders who purchase permits online may provide a description of the items being sold, identify categories of items being sold (e.g., "Antiques"), and download up to five photos of items included in the sale. Garage sale seekers may access the site to search and locate garage sales using item categories, dates and times of sales, and/or addresses. The search function filters sales and plots the results on a map and produces a listing of all sales which satisfy the search criteria. The results are printable (landscape print setting is recommended)
