Wichita Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Board Annual Report-2013

Dear Mayor Brewer and City Council members:

The Wichita City Council created the 11 member Wichita Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Board (WPAB) on February 5, 2013. The board's mission is to advise the City Council on matters related to bicycle and pedestrian policies, planning and projects, particularly those activities relating to the Wichita Master Bike Plan and the development of the Wichita Master Pedestrian Plan. The Board is pleased to provide the Wichita City Council with its first year report. Some of the major accomplishments of the Board during 2013 were:

- Formal establishment of the Board with monthly meetings
- Discussions with Park, Finance and City Engineering on bike and pedestrian requests for a new CIP
- Formation of a work team to develop draft bylaws
- Tracking and monthly reporting by Board members concerning approximately nine projects
- Recommendation on the proposed updates to the Delano West Douglas Avenue Bicycle Parking Plan
- Input on the Routine Accommodation Policy RFP
- Creation of a subcommittee to serve as the Pedestrian Master Plan Steering Committee
- Membership on the WAMPO Technical Advisory Committee
- Completion of an annual strategic planning retreat in November to set Board priorities for 2014.

Attached is the listing of the Board's priorities for 2014 and a copy of the Wichita Bicycle Master Plan 2013 Annual Implementation Progress Report. Through the Board's actions it is our hope to help make Wichita an even better place for people to walk and bicycle; and a healthier and safer community.
