Subject: Substantial Amendment to the 2015-2016 Second Program Year Action Plan

Dear Mayor, City Council and City Manager:

On behalf of the board we would like to thank the council for your approval of the Second Year Action Plan at the October 6, 2015 Council meeting which includes a number of community improvements for parks, sidewalks and streets. Of particular interest to the board is the inclusion of several proposed new pedestrian and bike path extensions:

- \$400,000 for construction of a Green Street Bikeway
- \$150,000 for a pedestrian crossing at 9th and McLean
- \$300,000 for construction of bikeways on Market and Topeka streets

These projects will provide residents of the designated neighborhoods with active transportation options for both education and employment. Additionally it will enhance work that has already been accomplished in the Wichita Master Bicycle and Pedestrian Plans and contribute to an active, safer, and healthier community for walking, running and biking.
