About ACT ICT: Our community has recently engaged residents in a number of planning discussions. This is the third phase of an effort to gather citizen input for planning. The first phase of focus groups provided input to the community survey that went to thousands of citizens earlier this year. It gathered information from citizens on issues that affect our future as a community, such as jobs, water, infrastructure like streets and sewers, public transportation, downtown, parks and recreation and more. ACT ICT is the third and final phase of this process to gather input directly from citizens on their vision for Wichita's future, the top priorities and preferred method of funding.
