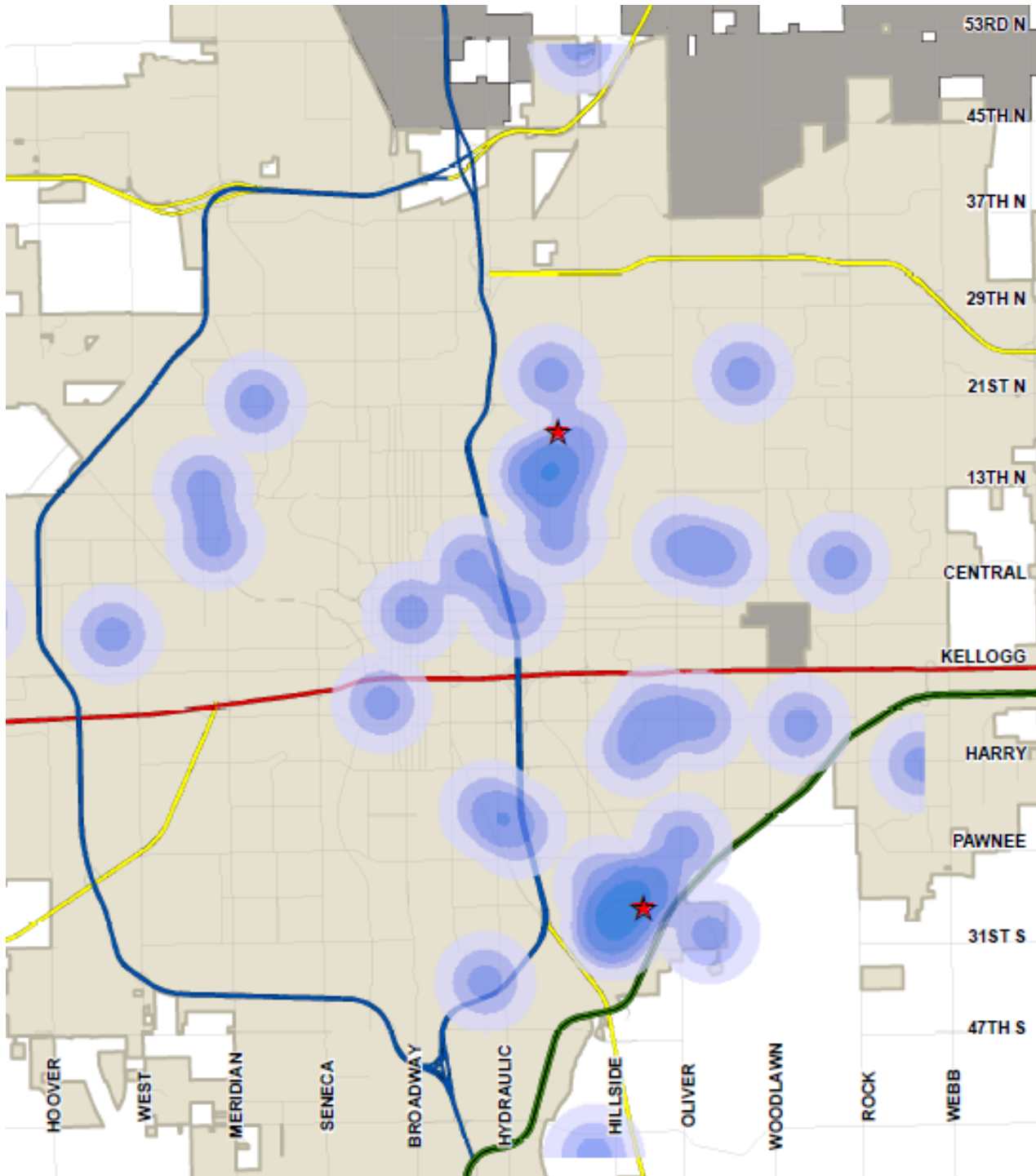


Day 2 report

Council District Break Out:

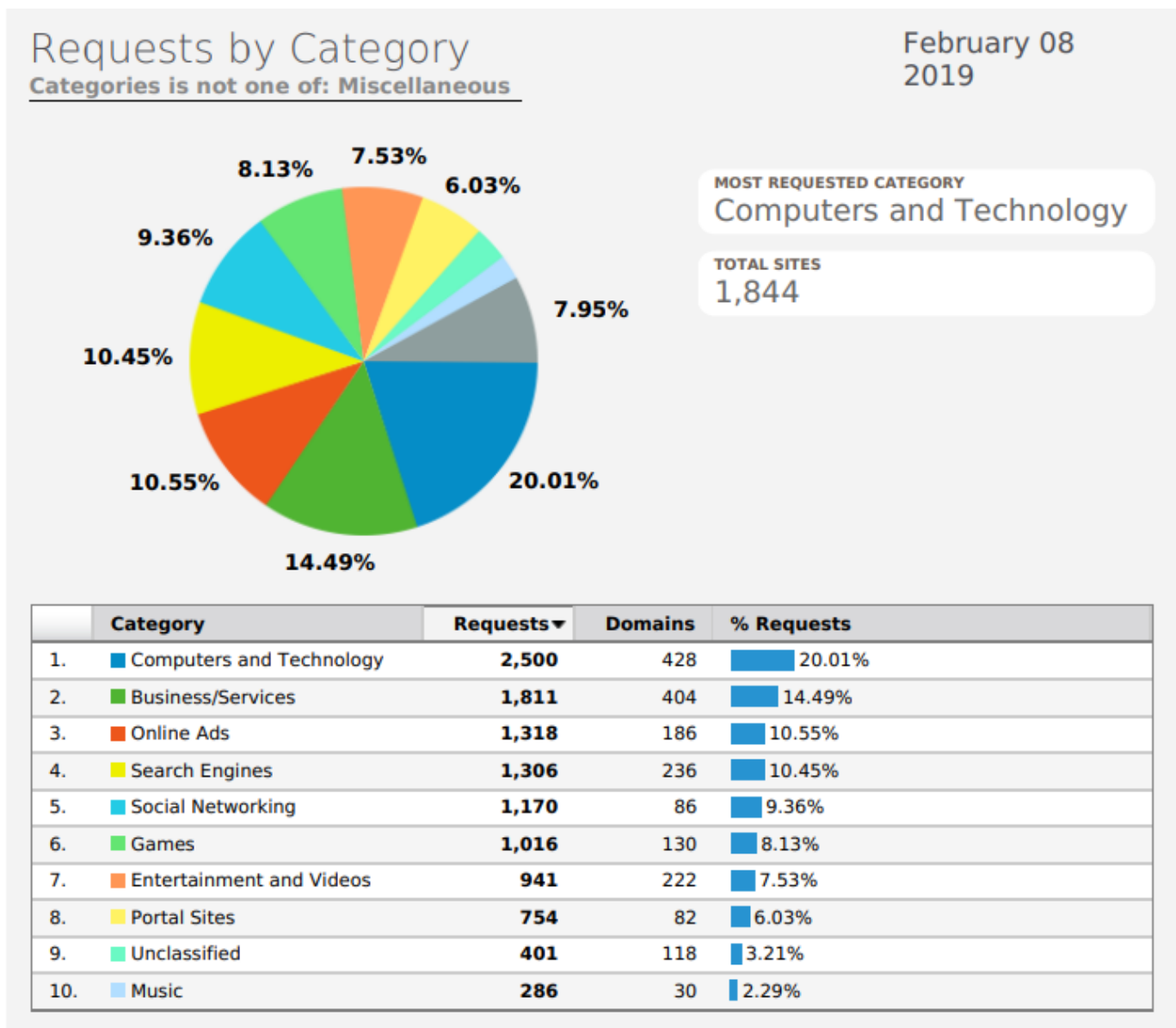
District 1 - 13

Usage Summary:

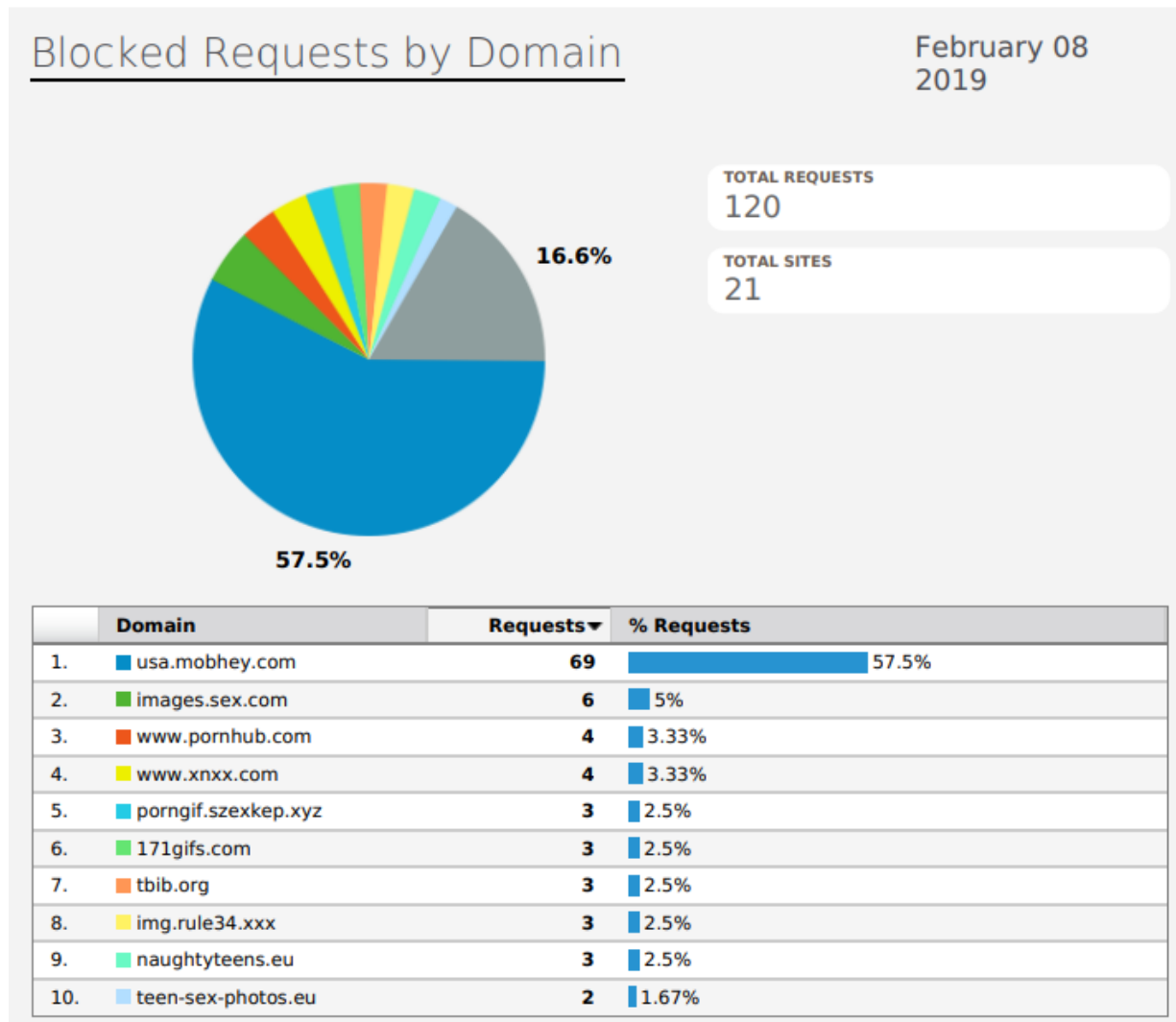
16,576 requests. 120 have been blocked. Less than 0.72%.
